

BACKGROUND

Our Mission and Vision

The first Race Relations Act came into force in Britain in 1965. The Act defined racial discrimination as treating one person less favourably than another on the grounds of race. It banned racial discrimination in public places and also made the promotion of hatred on the grounds of 'colour, race, or ethnic or national origins' an offence.

Over the years, there has been progress in legislation championing equality and providing legal recourse to people experiencing racial discrimination.

2025 marks 60 years since the Act, and of course, we know that racism is not dead in Britain, which is why we exist- to dismantle systemic racism in the UK. Our campaign is here to call out the racism that continues to exist in this country and encourage people to examine their own racial bias.


